I. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES OF THE BRACKENRIDGE

The University Honors College founded the **BRACKENRIDGE SUMMER FELLOWSHIP** Program in 1990 to provide two distinctive opportunities for the undergraduate who combines academic talent with scholarly motivation and intellectual scope.

First--through a two or three month summer stipend ---the Brackenridge seeks to provide an extended but continuous opportunity for *unfettered research and independent study* leading to a work of completed scholarship.

Second---through weekly seminars where Fellows present their work---the Brackenridge seeks to provide a supportive forum for discussion and *interdisciplinary intellectual fellowship*.

- IV. A brief written statement from your faculty research advisor indicating support for the project and a willingness to oversee the preparation of the abstract, paper and poster indicated in V. below.
- V. You must sign here _____ to indicate that you will obtain IRB approval if your research requires it (if unsure, consult your faculty advisor), that you will attend the summer meetings and that you will enroll in the one-credit **FALL UHC BRACKENRIDGE RESEARCH SEMINAR**, for which you will produce
 - i. An abstract summarizing your research project
 - ii. A work of independent scholarship in a form appropriate for publication based on your research from the Summer Brackenridge program, and
 - iii. A poster about your research to be presented at the **BRACKENRIDGE POSTER SESSION**.
- VI. Any additional information that you believe is relevant to an evaluation of your proposal.
